## How to Access HACS eEncyclopedias(A-Z)

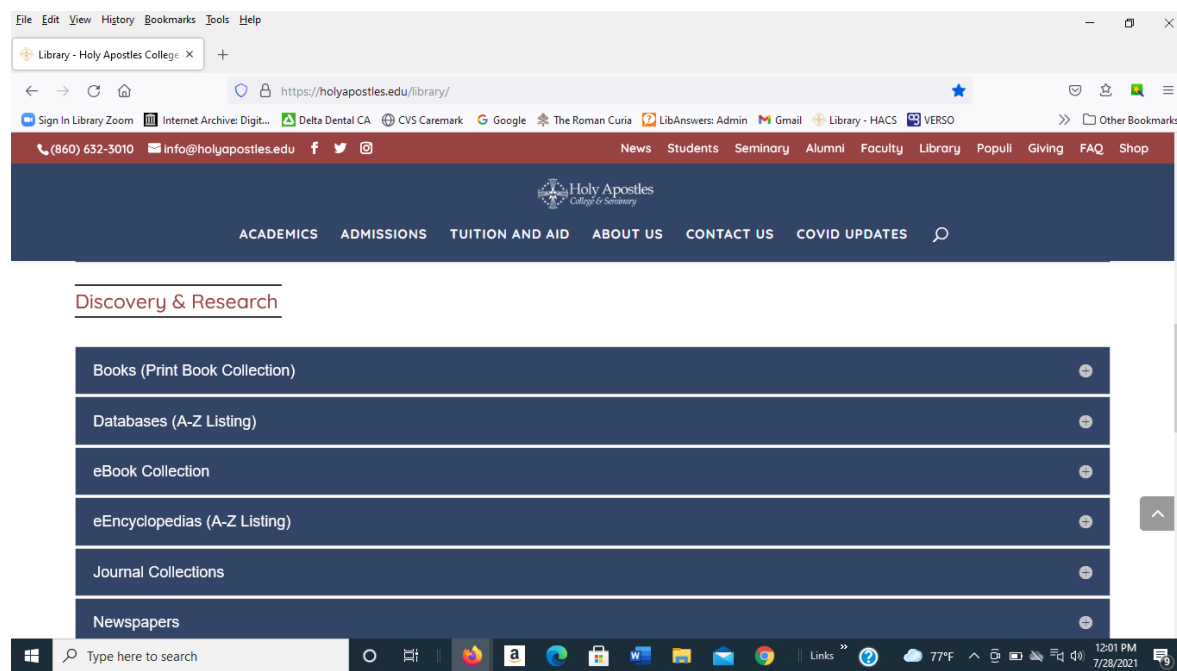
**You will need to locate your Patron ID/Library Barcode to access all of our eEncyclopedias.**(if you are off-campus)

Please follow these instructions to locate your Patron ID/Library Barcode:

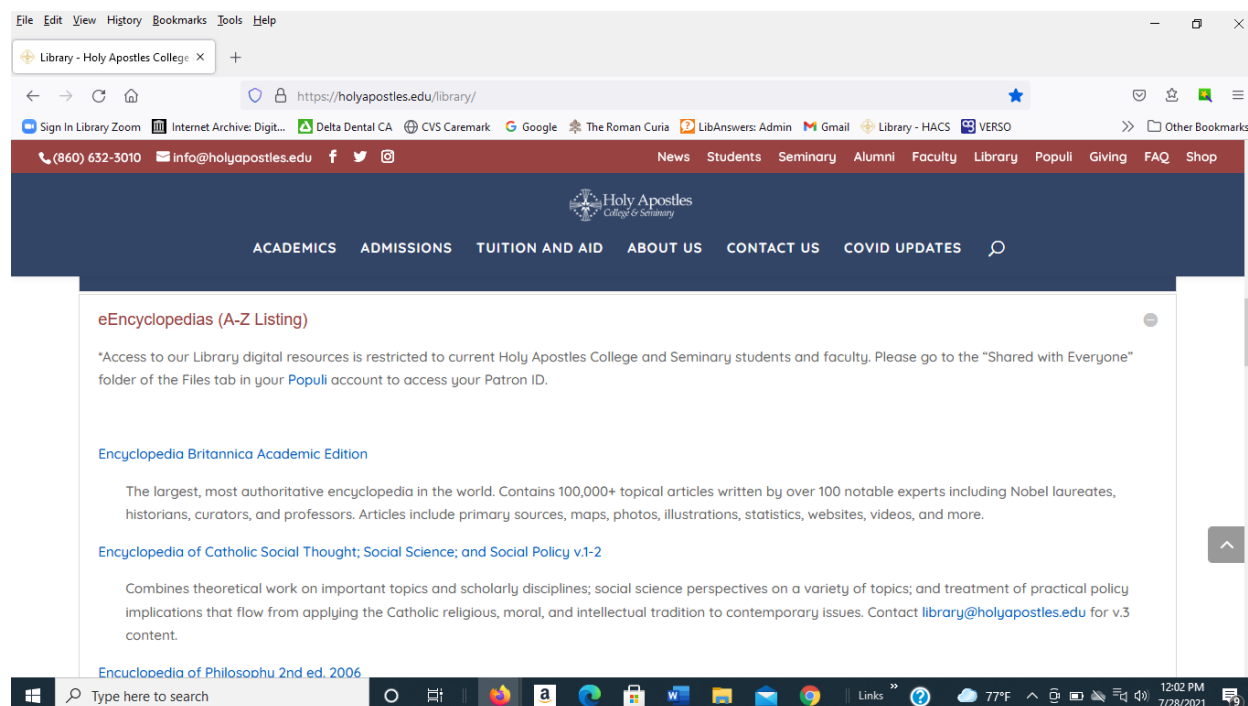
1. Log into Populi.
2. Go to the "Files" tab in the upper left-hand corner of your Populi account.
3. Select the "Shared with Academic Admin, Faculty, Staff, Students..." Folder.
4. Select the "Patron ID/Library Barcode" Word document.
5. Open this document to locate your 14-digit Patron ID/Library Barcode.
6. Use this 14-digit Patron ID/Library Barcode to access our online databases.

**To access the eEncyclopedias, follow these instructions and screenshots**

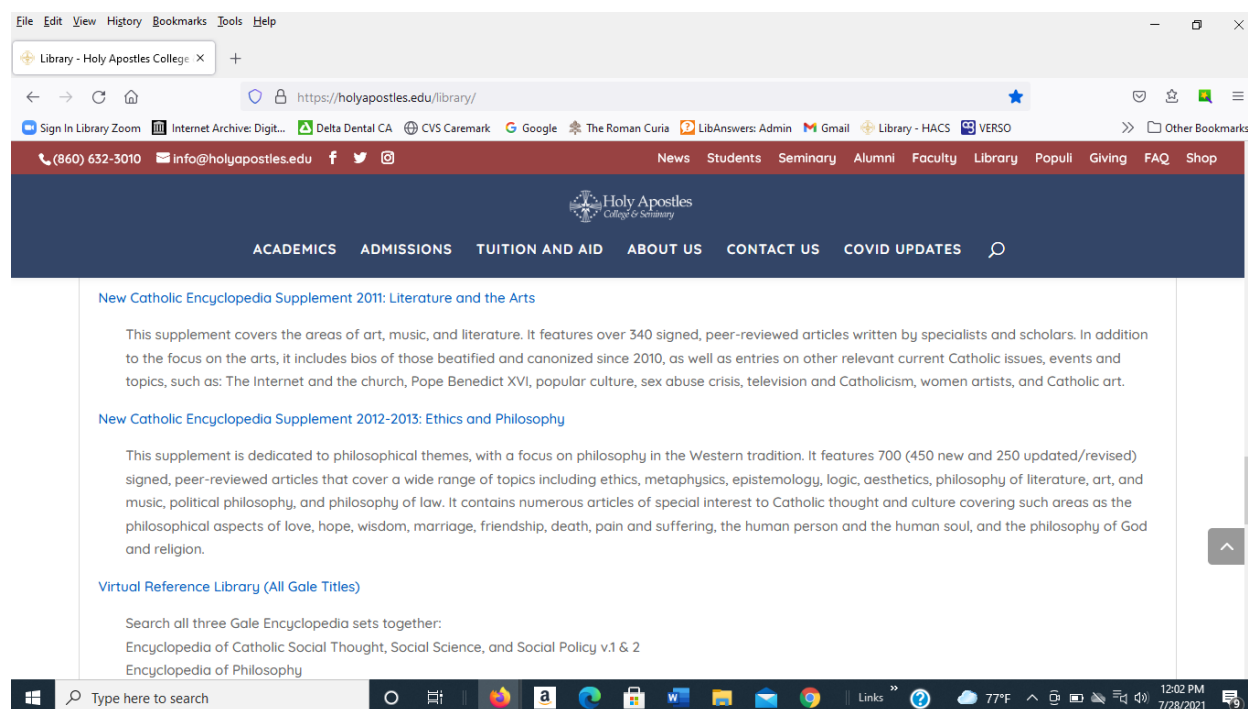
1. Go to the HACS library Webpage and locate eEncyclopedias(A-Z) under the Discovery and Research tab: <https://holyapostles.edu/library/>



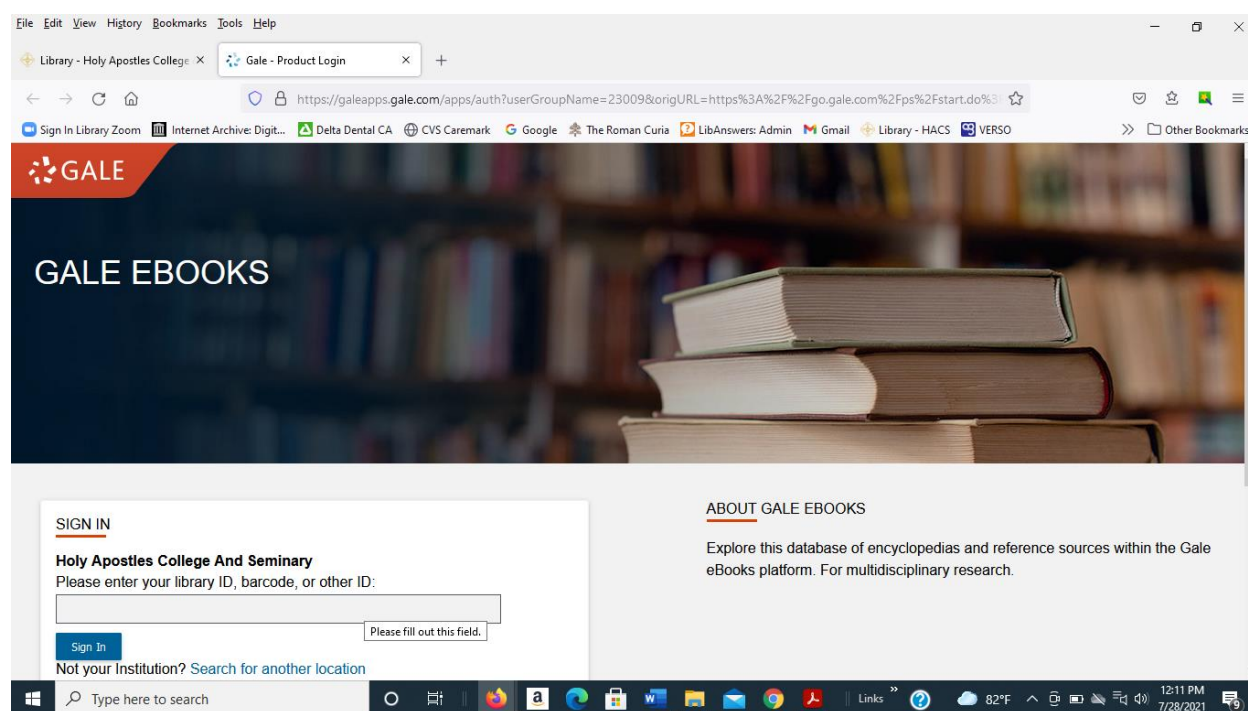
2. Click on eEncyclopedias. You may select an individual title or scroll down to the very last encyclopedia listed and select Virtual Reference Library (All Gale Titles)



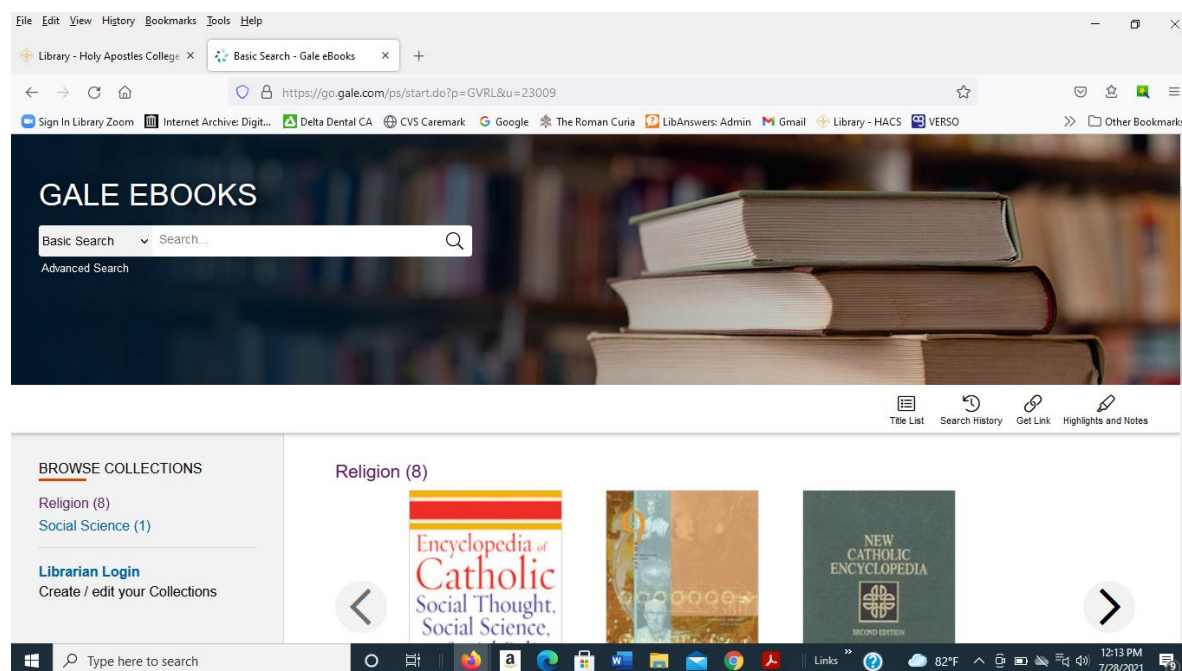

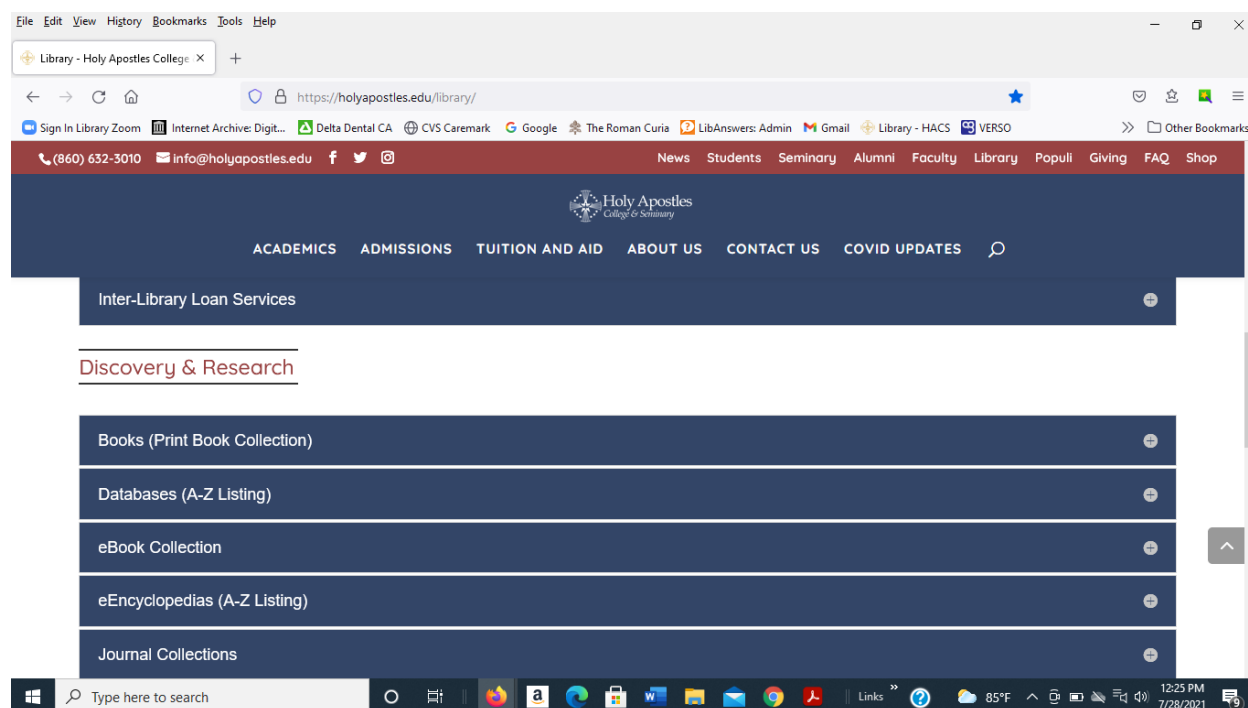
