Airports:

If you are flying from out of state, the closest airport to Holy Apostles is Bradley International Airport (Hartford/Springfield) located in Windsor Locks, CT. It is about 40 minutes from campus.

Lodging:

The Holy Apostles campus cannot accommodate lodging for graduating students and/or their guests. However, there are many hotels and accommodations nearby.

A block of rooms is reserved for Holy Apostles students and their families at the local Springhill Suites for the evenings of Friday, May 6, and Saturday, May 7. The address is 76 Berlin Road, Cromwell, CT 06416. The rate is \$139 per night and is subject to the 15% local sales tax and occupancy taxes. Graduation Fee & Diplomas:

All graduating students are required to pay the graduation fee of \$150. For those who completed the Current Format Comp Exam, the graduation fee was included with the fee for the exam.

On campus and online graduates: please make your payment through Populi.
Seminarians: the Business Office will send out invoices to your diocese for payment.

Please take note that academic and financial obligations must be met in order to receive your diploma and transcript. Diplomas ship in early-mid June.

Holy Apostles charges a graduation fee to cover the administrative costs associated with completing the graduation review, as well as printing and shipping your diploma. Eligible students are invited to participate in the annual on campus Commencement ceremony, for which the school does not charge an additional fee.

Attention Classes of 2020 and 2021: If you received your diploma in the mail, then you should have already paid the graduation fee. Please note that the graduation fee *does not* cover the cost of the cap/gown set (see above).
