Summative Evaluation

1. ENG 890 Comprehensive Exam and Professional Paper Course

The Comprehensive Examination is the normative summative evaluation. By exception, students ***may*** be granted permission to write a thesis based on approval of a thesis proposal. To submit a thesis proposal, a student must ***first*** complete ENG 891. ENG 891 counts as an elective, and ***if approved*** to write a thesis, the thesis directed study replaces the Comp Exam and Professional Paper Course.
