Holy Apostles College & Seminary (HACS) invites applications for a full-time, on-campus Assistant Professor of Theology, to begin August 2024. In addition to teaching both graduate and undergraduate Theology courses in person and online, this faculty member will act as coordinator of the Theology major in the Bachelor of Arts program.

Holy Apostles College and Seminary, a private, not-for-profit college located in Cromwell, CT, provides an affordable Catholic education that emphasizes faithfulness to the Magisterium. We offer the Bachelor of Arts degree, graduate degrees in Philosophy, Theology, Pastoral Studies, and Sacred Scripture, and a Master of Divinity in the New Evangelization.

All graduate classes are available online, and some are also taught on campus. Our Bachelor of Arts program is offered online only. With under one thousand students, HACS is looking for a professional who can work in a small campus environment as well as online.

Review of applications will begin March 18, 2024, and continue until the position is filled. The anticipated start date is August 2024.

Annual compensation: salary of \$60-65,000 per year with health benefits.

Requirements:

The successful candidate will possess a Ph.D. or S.T.D. at the time of appointment, demonstrate pedagogical and scholarly excellence, be supportive of the mission of a Catholic college as outlined by *Ex corde Ecclesiae*, demonstrate an understanding of and commitment to the Catholic philosophical tradition and the teachings of the Catholic Church, and be willing to take the Oath of Fidelity and

Profession of Faith. In addition, the successful candidate will have a strong foundation in the theology of St Thomas Aquinas and possess an expertise in 20th-21st century Catholic theology and magisterial documents.

Faculty Duties:

- Teach three courses per semester which can be a combination of graduate and undergraduate courses, taught on campus and online based on scheduling needs
- Hold weekly office hours and attend faculty meetings
- Serve on faculty committees
- Maintain an active research agenda

Administrative Duties:

- Serve as coordinator for the Bachelor of Arts Theology Major with duties including reviewing applications for admission, student advising, curricular reform, academic program reviews, overseeing assessment of student learning outcomes, and other duties as assigned.

- A one-to-two-page statement indicating how the candidate, through his/her research, teaching, and service, would make a distinctive contribution to HACCS' mission and to the vision of Catholic education outlined in the Apostolic Constitution on Catholic Universities, *Ex corde Ecclesiae*

- evidence of teaching effectiveness (e.g., student evaluations)
- official transcripts
